PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

The following is the schedule and information for dress rehearsal and 2026 Spring performance of Alice in Wonderland on **Saturday, JUNE 13, 2026**. The dress rehearsal and performance will be held at the Delaware Valley University Life Sciences Auditorium. Directions to the auditorium are available online at: [DELAWARE VALLEY UNIVERSITY LIFE SCIENCES DIRECTIONS](#) The Life Sciences Building is the big white and glass building visible from Route 202. It's best to turn onto New Britain Rd off Route 202, and then make a right onto Admissions Dr, the parking lot is on the right off Admissions Dr in front of the auditorium. Do not take Alumni Lane, this will bring you to the back of the building, not the front entrance.

On Saturday June 13, please arrive on time prepared with hair neat and pulled up in a bun, ballet pink tights, PINK ballet shoes and a nude leotard, and for boys- black shoes, black socks and black tights and black t-shirt. If ladies do not own a nude leotard for under the costume, you can wear a thin plain style camisole/spaghetti strap solid white/light pink color leotard (NO SKIRTS ATTACHED/ NO SLEEVES or TANK STRAP and NO FANCY CRISS CROSS STYLE STRAPS).

****Please arrive a little before your check-in time to use the restrooms before rehearsals and performance begin.****

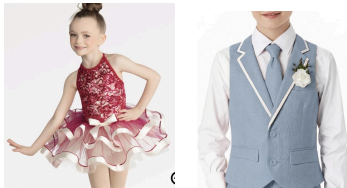
Additional important details:

- ★ PLEASE NOTE THAT A PHOTOGRAPHER WILL BE TAKING PICTURES FOR THE ENTIRE MORNING/AFTERNOON DRESS REHEARSAL. PLEASE COME TO THE THEATER PREPARED WITH HAIR / MAKEUP DONE! Please take note if your class was informed of a specific bun height for their headpiece placement. Thank you!!**
- ★ **Dress rehearsal is CLOSED to parents**- parents will not be allowed in the auditorium or backstage during dress rehearsal with the exception of Volunteer dressing room moms. The auditorium lobby is where you are able to wait for your dancers. Thank you.
- ★ **Performance Drop off/ Pick up procedures:** BACKSTAGE AND DRESSING ROOM AREA ARE FOR STAFF AND ASSIGNED VOLUNTEER ONLY. Everyone should enter in the front of the auditorium through the glass doors. Please send one parent/guardian to check in/out area for drop off and pick up. Walk straight back from the lobby to the check in area where a teacher or dressing room mom chaperone will meet you and direct your dancer to the correct dressing room. Be sure to leave the best cell phone number to be reached on the clipboard. After the dress rehearsal and performance finish, pickup will be located in the same area. Give the dancers some time after the scheduled rehearsal to get dressed. DO NOT enter the dressing room area even after the performance. A teacher or chaperone will bring children to the checkin/out area as they are ready. We can account for who is picked up and make sure everyone is checked out this way. Thank you for understanding.
- ★ Ballet shoes should be pink for girls and black for boys. Shoe strings should be trimmed, leave a couple inches, and tuck into shoes.
- ★ Small clear rhinestone or pearl stud earrings are allowed- NO JEWELRY OR ACCESSORIES

- ★ NO added hair accessories- hair neatly pulled back and sprayed with hairspray- please come with hair neatly done for BOTH the dress rehearsal and show(s)
- ★ NO NAIL POLISH
- ★ Make-up: black or brown eyeliner and mascara, neutral eye shadows, Pink or red Lipstick and light blush. Makeup optional for small children.
- ★ No eating or drinking besides water in costume. Pack your dancer a non messy, nut free snack for when they have a break between their dances. Definitely pack a water bottle labeled with their name.
- ★ **With the exception of one costume and coordinating headpiece per level LISTED BELOW, all other costumes, headpieces, and props must be returned to BABC.** If you do not want to keep your costume shown below you have the option to leave it at the auditorium dressing room and donate it to the studio.

Dancers may keep the following costume after the performance:

- Preballet- Roses costume- Cream and Dark red tutu and rosette headband ; Leo -White Rabbit suit - greyish blue and white



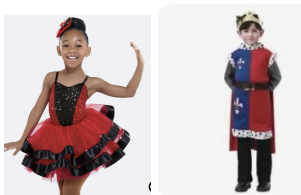
- Kinderballet - Hedgehog costume- grey leo and grey/blk tutu and hedgehog hat headpiece; also included but not wearing- a one piece grey hedgehog costume; Colin- Hedgehog one piece and Hat



- Ballet I - Roses Red and White tutu and. headband



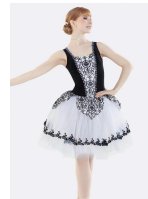
- Ballet I/II- Julian: King costume tunic and crownKing/Girls: black and red heart tutu and heart headband



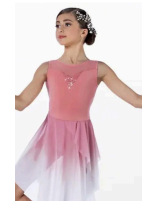
- Ballet II: Diamonds tutu and jewel crown and Boys- tweedle Costume



- Ballet III: Black and white spade and club tutu and blk hat headpiece.



- Ballet III/ IV- Flamingo costume and hat and gloves



- Ballet IV-VI- Garden dress various color and flower headpiece

**** Pack your water bottle with name and a non-messy, nut free snack for both dress rehearsal and performance (example goldfish/pretzels)**

DRESS REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

10:15am either "Alice" available and Ballet 3 Clubs and Spades (Isla, Abigail, Quinn and Olivia F in Hedgehog dance), please arrive and get into costume costume quickly

10:30-11:00 am All Dancers Levels I/II-VI Arrive and get into Act 2 costume

11:00am-11:45am FINALE REHEARSAL W/ BOTH FULL CASTS/ **ALL LEVELS** (Preballet, Kinderballet and Ballet 1 included)- Pointe dancers on flat

12:00p-1:15pm RUN THRU ALICE IN WONDERLAND ACT 2
***** start with croquet game for 4 little hedgehogs involved (get pointe shoes on quickly and most conveniently) (take small breaks when not called onstage)

1:15-2:45pm RUN THRU ALICE IN WONDERLAND ACT 1 (Ballet I/II Tea Party first and dismissed at 1:30p); then start at beginning of ACT 1 RUN THRU - Ballet II-III/IV around 1:45 or 2pm (hour break for Ballet II-III/IV)

2:45-3:00pm ANY BALLETT IV - VI REHEARSAL NEEDED

*Ballet IV-VI, it might be best to pack a lunch and dinner or have someone drop off a light dinner after your first performance.
Please plan accordingly for a long theatre day.

Bring your ticket confirmation or printed receipt for the auditorium door. Tickets are general admission and non-refundable (exception venue cancels event). Please double check your cast before purchasing tickets and share the cast information with family and friends purchasing tickets. Thank you.
